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Important Information:

Equipment – As your child enters UKS2, we encourage them to become more independent. If you would like to provide your child with some of the equipment listed below in a small, named pencil case (which will fit in their tray) for their individual use, please feel free to do so.

- Pencil
- Ruler
- Sharpener
- Rubber
- Glue stick
- Colouring crayons
- Pair of scissors



Other than the small pencil case and stationery listed above, your children will need to bring: their reading book (and Guided Reading book), Reading Record, packed lunch (if not having a hot dinner), water bottle, a weather-appropriate coat and outdoor shoes you don't mind them getting wet and muddy for any outdoor lessons taking place in wet weather.



PE Days:

- Foxgloves - Wednesday (double PE).
- Lupins - Tuesday and Friday.
- Sunflowers - Tuesday (double PE).



Please ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit on their PE days.

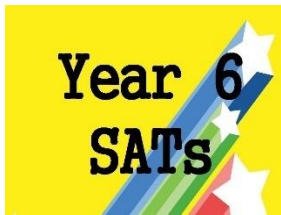
Our PE kit consists of: a plain white t-shirt or polo-shirt, plain black shorts or PE skirt, a plain black sweatshirt, plain black jogging trousers and trainers

Reading - All children will take part in Guided Reading within their classes, with follow up activities to be completed in school. They may also bring these books home to read ahead for the next session. In addition, each child is expected to have an **individual reading** book suitable for their own reading ability, available in school at all times. The children should record details of their own reading in their reading record book; both reading at school and reading at home (it is expected that the diary is brought into school every day). **Our school expectation is that, on at least three occasions a week, you discuss a book/text with your child and make an entry in their reading diary, ensuring it is then signed.**



Homework - Each week, your child will bring home spelling patterns/words to learn, which will be tested in school. They will also be set homework on Maths.co.uk, TT Rock Stars and SPaG.com. The Maths and SPaG homework will usually be set alternate weeks, but the TT Rockstars Homework will be set every week. Homework will usually be set on a Friday; it will be expected back by the following Friday, unless the children are otherwise told.

Important dates:



As usual, Year 6 pupils will be taking their SATs (Statutory Assessment Tests) in the Summer Term. These will take place from **Monday 11th to Thursday 14th May 2026**. Further to this, the Year 6 writing assessment continues until the end of June. Please make sure your child does not miss any school time leading up to and during this important period.



The Year 5 residential to **Boggle Hole** will take place from **Monday 22nd to Wednesday 24th September**. The Year 6 residential to **Hagg Farm** will take place from **Monday 18th to Friday 22nd May**. Further details on Hagg Farm will be available in the Autumn Term.



Both year groups will take part in end of year performances and will need to be in school for all rehearsals during late June and July. Year 6 pupils will also have their Leavers' Party and a Leavers' Service in the last week of the Summer Term.
