Walking Home

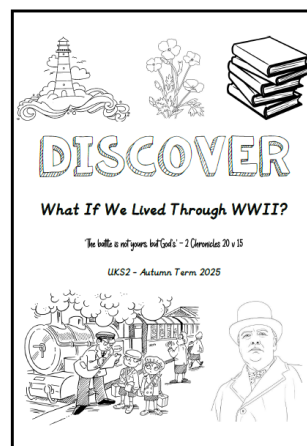
