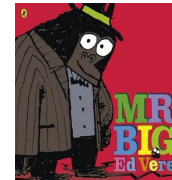
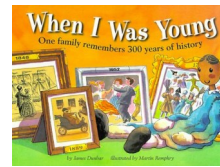
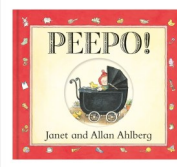
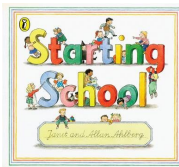
Foundation Stage Autumn 2

Literacy



This half term, we have linked our literacy learning to our topic: The History of me. We have read some brilliant stories to ignite children's curiosity and imagination. We have explored how things have changed over time and have spent time looking at historical artefacts. We had a special visitor, Mr Bethell (Mrs Foxall's Dad) who told us what life was like for him as a boy. He showed us photographs from the past and we looked at his Grandfather's war medals.

phonics

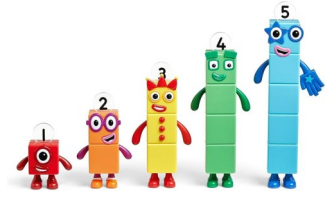
Phonics

The children have made incredible progress with our Twinkl Phonics programme this term. The children have really engaged with the lessons and love learning about the adventures of Kit and Sam!

Research shows that hearing your child read at least three times per week at home and sharing favourite stories regularly has a significant impact on their reading progress in school. We thank you for your continued support with this.

Maths

The children have thoroughly enjoyed our maths sessions, using the NCETM Mastering Number programme which uses the very popular Numberblocks series to support the children's engagement and continued interest. The children are becoming confident mathematicians and enjoy exploring with mathematical manipulatives.
