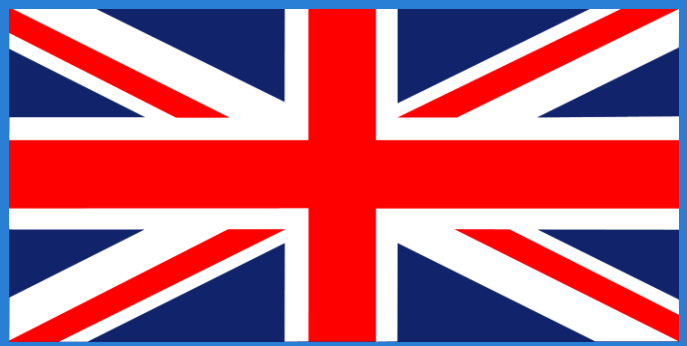


Farnsfield St Michael's CofE Primary School Newsletter
